Conas cur leis an tacaíocht a thugann tú do do pháiste: *How you can support your child:*

Coinnigí oraibh le roinnt léitheoireachta i rith an tsamhraidh.

Continue reading together during the summer.

Ba mhaith an rud é nós na léitheoireachta a choinneáil suas, más féidir.

It would be a good thing to keep up the habit of reading, if possible.

Má léann sibh le chéile, pléigí a mbíonn léite agaibh.

If you are reading together, talk about what you have just read.

Teastaíonn breis tacaíochta ó X sa léitheoireacht, mar go léann sé an-mhall.

X requires extra support with reading, because s/he reads very slowly.

Gabhfaidh sé chun tairbhe dó/di má léann tuismitheoir in éineacht leis/léi.

It will benefit him/her if a parent reads with him/her.

Má thógann sibh sealanna ag léamh, beidh seans ag X sult a bhaint as na pictiúir/ as an scéal.

If you take turns when reading, X will have the opportunity to enjoy the pictures/ the story.

Iarr ar X cur síos a dhéanamh ar an méid a bhíonn léite aici/aige.

Ask X to retell what s/he has read.

Is cleachtadh maith é siollaí na bhfocal a rá.

It is good practice to say the syllables in the words.

Bainigí úsáid as an leabharlann poiblí chun teacht ar réimse leabhair Ghaeilge agus Bhéarla.

Make use of the public library to access a range of books in both Irish and English.

Is féidir leabhair dheasa Ghaeilge agus Bhéarla a fháil ón leabharlann phoiblí, saor in aisce.

Lovely Irish and English books are available, free of charge, in the public library.

Coinnigí oraibh ag déanamh cleachtaí ar na fónaicí/táblaí.

Carry on together practicing the phonics/tables.

Tógai gí sealanna ag comhaireamh in 2anna, 5anna, 10 anna.

Take turns counting in 2s, 5s, 10s.

Éisteacht Ghníomhach Active Listening

Tabhair tascanna beaga do X le déanamh timpeall an tí, rud a fhorbróidh neamhspleáchas, féinmhuinín, agus cumas éisteachta.

Give X little jobs to do around the house, this will help develop independence, self-confidence, and listening skills.

Iarr ar X insint ar ais duit an méid a dúirt tú, chun an tuiscint ar a gcloiseann sí/sé a fheabhsú.

Ask X to repeat to you what you said, this will help improve his/her understanding of what s/he heard.

Is léir go dtugann sibh tacaíocht do X leis an obair scoile sa bhaile. Tá an-suim aige/aici san fhoghlaim dá bharr.

It is evident that you support X with the schoolwork at home. S/he has an interest in learning as a result.

Is léir gur thug sibh an-tacaíocht do X i rith an dianghlasála. Tá rath ar a chuid/cuid foghlama dá bharr.

It is evident you have given X lots of support during the lockdown. S/he has been successful in his/her learning as a result of this.
